Courts and Resurfacing

As you may have noticed during home matches, the resurfacing project for the courts has begun with new posts and nets installed. We estimate the major works will occur mid-November but that is all up to the weather!

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When dates are finalised, all scheduled home matches will be relocated to alternative venues.

The court surface has been damaged in places by clean up from the prep work for the post holes and the recent rains. Please be mindful of this when on court.

Please note and be careful of the off court erosion that has occurred on the south side (car park) end of the concreted standing area. The floods of early October really took their toll and washed debris over the courts have undercut the concrete. The good news is the Netball Club have Randall Weeks and Finch Cowlam on the job and they are going to landscape this corner to a safe standard. Take care with this area as it is hazardous at the moment.

Grants

Your committee is excited to advise that we have fully funded the court resurfacing project with grants and there is no additional payment required from the clubs reserves. This is an unprecedented result for our club and has taken a lot of work to get to this point. When the project is complete, we will thank our generous funders with some publicity (possibly a photo opportunity with a local MP and some club members sporting our new attire). 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Recipe

Spiced Cauliflower, Pumpkin Seed and Carrot Salad with Tahini Lemon Dressing



Ingredients

1 head of cauliflower cut into florets
1 tspn sea salt
1 heaped tablespoon sumac (can use lemon
rind as a substitute)
1 teaspoon chili flakes
ground pepper
¼ cup olive oil
¼ cup dried cranberries (can omit)
½ cup pumpkin seeds
2-3 large carrots peeled into thin ribbons

2 cups baby spinach
parsley leaves

Tahini Lemon Dressing (place all ingredients
into a jar and shake together. Then place lid
and store leftovers in the fridge)

1/3 cup olive oil (cold pressed if you can)
1/3 cup white wine vinegar
1 clove garlic, crushed
1 tablespoon tahini
juice of 1 lemon
2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
1 teaspoon poppy seeds
1 tablespoon maple syrup
1 tablespoon chopped chives
salt and ground pepper

Method

Step 1 - Preheat oven to 200 degrees or (180
degrees fan forced). Line a large baking tray
with baking paper.

Step 2 – In a large bowl toss together
cauliflower, salt, sumac, chili flakes, pepper
and olive oil. Spread onto prepared tray and
bake for 40 minutes or until golden and
roasted.

Step 3 – Make Tahini Lemon Dressing

Step 4 – Toss the roasted cauliflower,
cranberries, pumpkin seeds, carrots and
spinach leaves together, drizzle with salad
dressing (you won't need all of it), scatter with
parsley and serve.

Can serve as a side dish with fish or meat of
your choice or enjoy on its own.
